#### Discrete Subjects

**Religious Education:** People – Domestic Church, family / Called – Baptism and Confirmation, belonging / Other faiths – Hinduism, Advent / Christmas – loving: gift

**Maths:** Number and Place value (including ordering, counting in multiples, rounding, problem solving), Addition and Subtraction (including mental and formal written methods, money, applying this to problems), Geometry (2D and 3D shapes), Measurement (perimeter) and Multiplication and Division (including times table facts, formal written methods and two step problems)

**English:** Roman Myths and legends / Stories with dilemmas / Newspaper Reports / Persuasive writing / Poetry

**Science:** Animals, including humans / Sound
