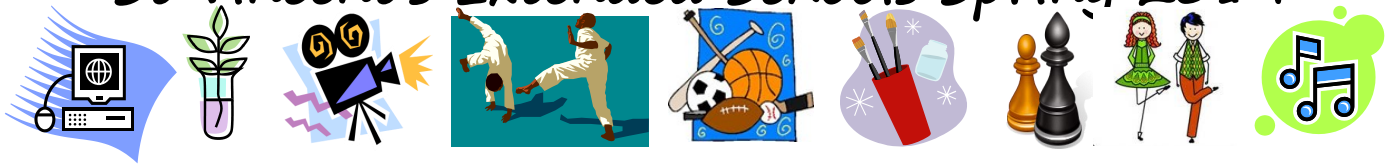


# St Vincent's Extended Schools Spring 2019



At St. Vincent's, we are dedicated to providing a varied Extended Schools programme for all children from Reception Class to Year 6. On the back of this letter is the timetable of extra-curricular activities for this term for your information. There is a charge per club, per term in order to cover costs. Despite having a very busy week, all of our teachers contribute to an extra curricular activity. We are grateful to them for their time and commitment to do this. We also offer some extra curricular activities which are run by outside agencies. We constantly monitor the number and range of clubs available to the different age groups. Some of the clubs are kept small in order to give the children more individual attention but which means that children can only attend for one term in order to give everyone a chance. Some of the clubs are seasonal and will therefore only run in certain terms. The number of activities available increases as the children progress up the school. This is due to the fact that we have found that after a long day at school, many of the youngest children are often too tired to engage in extra activities. However we hope you find that there is something for everyone.

## How to apply/pay for clubs:

### Breakfast Club (Years Nursery-6)

This club runs every day from 8.00-8.55am: Please contact the School Office

### After School Activity Club (Years Reception-6)

This club runs every day from 3.15-5.15pm: Please contact the School Office

### Music Lessons (Years Reception-6)

Please contact the school office about Drum, Cello or Piano lessons.

### Chess Club (Years Reception-6)

Please pay and give permission for these clubs by sending in the attached permission slip plus payment (cash/cheque) to the School Office in a labelled envelope by Thursday 10.01.19. Please note that it is not possible to pay for these clubs via ParentPay. It is also no longer possible to pay via bank transfer. Apologies for any inconvenience caused. Please see Miss Siswick (Nursery) with any queries or concerns.

### FOR ALL OTHER CLUBS

Please log on to 'Parent Pay' to give permission and to pay £20 for each of the School led clubs your child is interested in attending by Thursday 10.01.19. You will be refunded if there is no space available. As we do not want any children to miss out for financial reasons, if you have any difficulties making clubs payments, please contact Miss Coleman as soon as possible even if your child has previously been granted a free place.

### How to find out if your child has received a place in their chosen club/s:

- ♦ The names of all children allocated places in the various clubs will be e-mailed to you by Friday 11th January.
- ♦ Please make a note of the days, times and dates of the relevant clubs. The places are allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis.
- ♦ Please do not send your child to a club unless their name is on the list.
- ♦ Please see me as soon as possible or contact me via the School Office if your child's name is not on the list.
- ♦ All these clubs will start in the second week of the Spring Term 2019 (beginning Monday 14th January and continue until the week beginning Monday 25th March) Please note that there are no after school clubs (except After School Activity Club) on Wednesday 27th and Thursday 28th March due to Parents' Evenings.
