Project Outline:

Over the week project, young people will work with lead and guest facilitators taking part in a range of creative workshops to develop their creative, personal and social skills.

The project will support young people to:

- Get back into the routine of going to school and the timings of the school day.
- Socialise and work together with others supporting their teamwork and communications skills.
- Creatively **explore their thoughts and feelings** around the themes of change, tolerance and fitting in helping them prepare to make their transition to secondary school.
- **Build positive relationships** with their peers through being active and creative and have opportunities to share and present to others.
- **Reduce anxiety** about leaving home, being around others and transitioning to secondary school.

The project will be delivered in line with government guidance on Covid-19 adhering to information on social distancing and class sizes.
