
## Welcome back to school!








## We hope you had a lovely summer and we are looking forward to seeing you!










The new academic year starts on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> September for all children from Reception to Year 6 (Nursery will start later in the term).

Pupils can arrive at school any time between 8:30 and 8:55a.m.

Breakfast Club will start at 8:00 from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September and you enter through the school office.





We are still aware of coronavirus but it is safe for you to come to school. Some things will be the same as before and others may be different but the teachers will help you understand any changes to your school routine.







All pupils must wear school uniform (unless it is your birthday when you can wear your own clothes!). From September until October half term pupils can choose to wear Summer or Winter uniform, depending on the weather.



If it is a Physical Education (P.E. day) pupils should come to school wearing their P.E. kit. The days will be clear on the Class page of the school website.

Pupils should bring in an appropriate sized school bag for their water bottle, reading books and homework.

On the first day, Nursery, Reception and Class 1 pupils should bring in a spare set of clothes which will be named and kept at school.



Face masks will not be worn by pupils or staff during the school day. If pupils choose to wear a face mask when travelling, you will have to take this off outside school and store it during the day in a sealed bag in your school bag. You will be able to put it on again when you leave school.







Pupils can arrive any time between 8:30-8:55 during the Soft Start.

Miss Coleman, Mrs Duffy or Miss Carruthers (and sometimes Molly!)

will be there to greet pupils and administer hand sanitiser.

We are so looking forward to seeing you!







During the day we will continue to wash our hands regularly.










We will maintain the 'up stairs' and 'down stairs' to help us move around the school safely.
