## Coming back to school!












My school has been closed because of coronavirus.



We all had to stay at home to keep everyone safe.




The virus is now not spreading as fast as it was.

I will get up and get ready in the morning. I will wear my school uniform.




If it is my PE day, I will come to school in my PE kit.

Some things will be different but the teachers will help me to understand the changes to my school routine.




There is no access from Marylebone High Street because of road works, so I may have to walk a longer way around to get to the entrance.

There will be lots of exciting new things to learn and activities to do.




If we need to work in a smaller group, then we can use our support room.

I will have all my break and lunch times in my bubble. My bubble is made up of Class 4 and Class 3.




In my bubble, I can play with any of the children but the adults will keep 2m away from all of us to keep social distancing.

At lunch, we will have hot meals again. We have to bring our own water bottles to the hall for lunch.











We have 'up stairs' and 'down stairs' to help us move around the school safely. There are signs to remind us which way to go.





During the day we will be washing our hands a lot more often than before.




Only one bubble can use the toilets at a time. My teacher will give me the 'toilet person' to stick on the door so that other children know which bubble is using it at that time.
