## **School Uniform**

It is our school policy that all children wear school uniform when attending school, representing the school, or when participating in a school-organised event outside normal school hours.

Our policy is based on the notion that school uniform:

- promotes a sense of pride in the school;
- engenders a sense of community and belonging towards the school;
- identifies the children with the school;
- makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance;
- is regarded as suitable wear for school and good value for money by most parents;
- is designed with health and safety in mind.

We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the school uniform policy. We believe that parents have a duty and responsibility to send their children to school correctly dressed in the correct uniform, that it is clean and in good repair and they have all they need for their day.

Many uniform items can be purchased from most department stores but the uniform containing the school logo can only be purchased using our uniform website www.stitchdesign.co.uk Uniform items with the school logo are <u>compulsory</u>. Please always refer to this leaflet when ordering uniform.

The school office has some small items such as hats, ties, badges and water bottles available to buy, as well as our school rucksacks. The St Vincent's Parents Association (SVPA) frequently hold second-hand uniform sales for parents to buy items at a greatly reduced price.

## FOUNDATION STAGE UNIFORM Nursery & Reception class only

-Plain navy blue tracksuit bottoms (not trousers or leggings) or plain navy blue shorts

-Navy blue sweatshirt with school logo

-Light blue polo shirt with school logo

-Plain navy blue or white socks/tights

-Plain black trainers or shoes (no open-toed sandals, slip-on shoes, boots, footwear with coloured detail or flashing lights.)

-School coat or duffle coat with school logo (a plain navy blue coat can be worn with school badge sewn on –badges to be purchased in the school office.)

-Small school rucksack with school logo

-Navy blue woollen hat or school cap with school logo

Every item of clothing must be labelled clearly inside with your child's name.

No jewellery is to be worn except for a watch or stud earrings. Pupils should not wear extreme hair fashions and, if hair is long enough to be tied back, it should be, with a small blue or white hair band.



## AUTUMN / SPRING UNIFORM Key Stage 1&2

#### Boys

- -Light blue shirt
- -School tie
- -Navy blue v-neck jumper with school logo (not a sweatshirt)
- -Plain navy blue trousers (not denim, cords or chinos)

#### Girls

-Light blue shirt

-School tie

- -Navy blue v-neck jumper or cardigan with school logo (not a sweatshirt)
- -Plain navy blue trousers (not denim, leggings, cords or chinos), pinafore or skirt (at least knee length)

## SUMMER UNIFORM Key Stage 1&2

#### (Optional from Easter to October Half Term depending on the weather)

#### Boys

- -Light blue polo shirt with school logo
- -Plain blue navy shorts
- Girls
- -Summer dress in light blue and white checked material.
- Trousers are <u>not</u> an option for girls in the summer term.

### P.E. UNIFORM Key Stage 1&2

- -Plain navy blue jogging bottoms (no details) for WINTER
- -Plain navy blue shorts (no details) for SUMMER
- -White polo shirt with school logo
- -Plimsolls / trainers for outdoor games
- -Navy blue school PE bag with school logo

-Plain navy blue or white socks/tights

-Plain black trainers or shoes (no trainers, open-toed sandals, slip-on shoes, boots, footwear with coloured detail or flashing lights.)

-School coat or duffle coat with school logo (a plain navy blue coat or blazer can be worn with school badge sewn on – badges to be purchased in the school office.)

-Navy blue woollen hat or school cap with school logo

-Navy blue school rucksack with school logo

Every item of clothing must be labelled clearly inside with your child's name.

No jewellery is to be worn except for a watch or stud earrings. Pupils should not wear extreme hair fashions and, if hair is long enough to be tied back, it should be, with a small blue or white hair band.
