### **Class 5 Information      Autumn 2018**

Dear Parent/Carers,

We hope you all had a wonderful summer holiday. Welcome back to a new school year, and a special welcome to Year 5!

This year, Class 5 have two class teachers: Mrs Avdiu (Monday, Tuesday and Friday) and Mrs Robinson (Wednesday and Thursday).

Our first topic is 'Invaders & Settlers'. The class will be learning about different settlers (Romans, Anglo-Saxons and Vikings) and types of settlements. They will then create their own settlements and think about a different aspect of their community each week such as: discovering, naming and mapping our island; constructing our island showing all relevant physical features; creating a government / policing body to preside over our settlement, plotting the development of the settlements and finally completing a special project to celebrate our learning.

#### **Class Information**

P.E. lessons take place on Tuesday (swimming) and Friday (outdoor P.E.). Children must bring in their swimming kit (which includes a towel and swimming caps as well as appropriate swimming costumes) and the full school P.E. kit (all clearly labelled with their names) to school on these days. Children may bring a sensible pencil case to school with all items labelled.

**Homework will be given out on Wednesdays and must be returned the following Monday.**

**Maths Homework** will comprise of learning facts for our weekly mental maths tests and exercises linked to what we are learning in class will be available on Mathletics. English homework will consist of spellings, a grammar exercise and a reading comprehension. Children should also complete one task every week from their creative curriculum matrix and reflect on the Wednesday word.

In addition to this, children should read for at least 20 minutes each day at home and practise / learn their Times Tables.
