
Hoarding move along Aybrook Street.


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Pit lane:

We will progressively be opening up our pit lane on Aybrook Street to off load deliveries. This will occur in stages by moving the current hoarding back enabling the current road to be widened. The works will slowly progress from St Vincent road up to Moxon road. These works will be completed in April.



Scaffolding:

Following the hoarding move, over the Easter holiday, we will be commencing the scaffold protection over St Vincent Street. This will then be followed by the main scaffolding to enclose the site.
