## Dear Neighbour,

Since the last update we have completed the structure up to level 1 .

On the south side of site we are already working on level 6. The structure is on track to complete during August 2022.
Internal blockwork and M\&E works are progressing as planned in the basement areas.


Our pit lane, on Aybrook Street for deliveries has been fully established and our hoists are operational.

## Upcoming works:

Over the coming month you will see the external scaffold being installed around the perimeter of site. This enables the external cladding to commence, with window installation due to start over the coming weeks.

Our northern tower crane is due to be dismantled and re-erected on top of the north stair core. These works will take place on Thursday $7^{\text {th }}$, Friday $8^{\text {th }}$ and Saturday $9^{\text {th }}$ July.

Over the school summer holiday, from the $25^{\text {th }}$ July 2022 there will be gas installation works on Cramer street and St Vincent Street. We will circulate more information in the upcoming weeks.
